



Maricopa Community Colleges Request for Articulation Form

Baccalaureate degree granting institutions who are interested in developing a formal partnership with the Maricopa Community Colleges must meet the following criteria:

- Have full accreditation with a regional accreditation commission such as the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.
- Understand that the agreement is on behalf of the district as a whole and not with individual colleges within the district. Courses taken at any of the Maricopa Community Colleges are equally transferable to institutions entering into an articulation agreement.
- Agree to all transfer Associate Degrees (Associate in Arts, Associate in Business, Associate in Science, Associate in Arts Elementary Education) awarded by Maricopa.
- Accept coursework beyond 64 credits to provide students with greater flexibility and/or offer meaningful incentives to students (e.g. waiver of application fees, dedicated scholarships, and advising, etc).
