

Special Characters in Naming Conventions

Special Characters being used in Bb naming conventions continue to be a problem. We strongly recommend that no special characters be used in the names of any files.

For Example: Use Assignment 1 not Assignment #1

When creating names in Bb:

Only use: A-Z, a-z, 1-9, hyphen - , and/or underscore_

Don't use:

spaces

\ (backslash)

/ (forward slash)

: (colon)

; (semi-colon)

** (asterisk)*

? (question mark)

" (double quotes)

< (left angle bracket)

> (right angle bracket)

| (pipe)

% (percent)

, (comma)

(pound or number)

\$ (dollar)

! (exclamation)

+ (plus)

{ (left bracket)

} (right bracket)

& (ampersand)

[(left square bracket)

] (right square bracket)

• (bullet = ASCII #149)

' (apostrophe)
