MAT Reclassification Project

CEC is preparing to interview 200-250 people. Interviews will be conducted on an individual or group (4-5 people) basis. Jan recommended IR should be interviewed as a group. It was agreed that IR Council recommends a group interview consisting of Mary Day, Linda Hawbaker, Rene' Wilikens, Marina Gorton, and Georgia Gudykunst.

Information To High Schools Regarding their Graduates

After some discussion about providing information to high schools about their graduates, it was decided that it is an A/R responsibility. Any information that is provided should have the approval of A/R. It was noted this information couldn't be compiled District-wide given the A/R view. However, Linda will raise the issue with Mary Lou Massal (GCC) about providing a list of students attending/graduating MCCD schools.

Retention Issues/Measures

Georgia reported there is a big push to develop measures. Georgia & Mary are meeting with Student Services Deans to address system-wide retention issues. Georgia requested ideas for measures be submitted to her, as well as the measures and definitions the Researchers are using.

DSS Issues

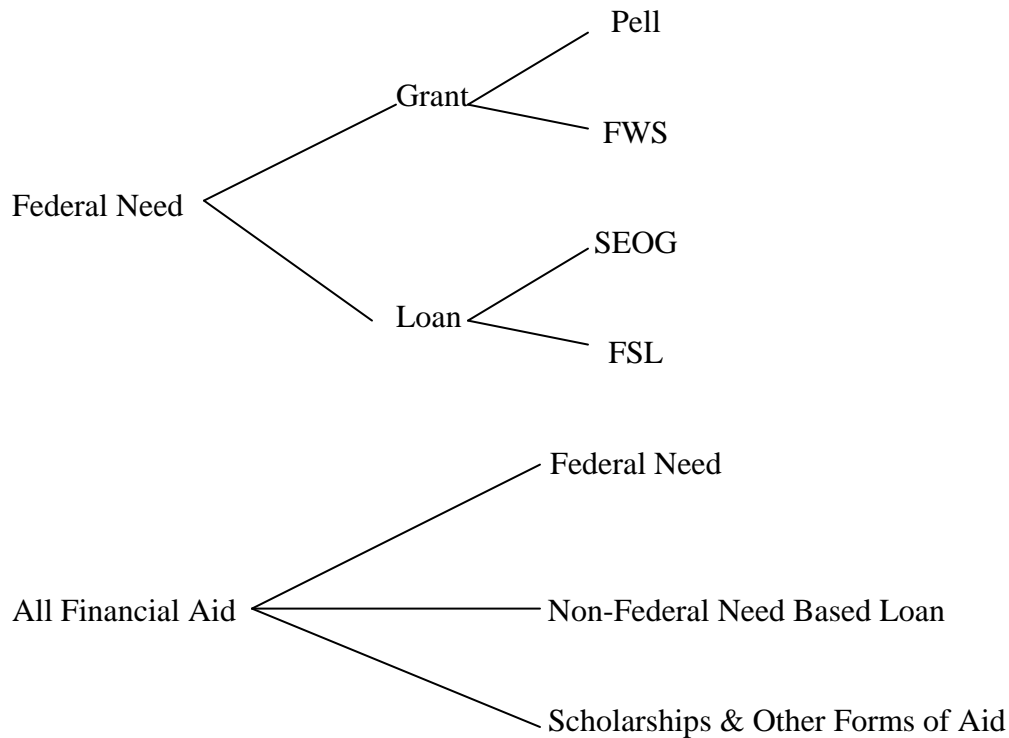
