**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Governing Board approve an Intergovernmental Agreement between Scottsdale Community College and Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (SRPMIC) for Firefighting Training.

**Justification**

After evaluating the firefighter training course content and instructional guidelines according to the College’s curriculum criteria, Scottsdale Community has determined that the SRPMIC current training classes qualify for college credit, and how much credit can be offered per class.

The SRPMIC and the College desire to enter into a mutually beneficial agreement under which SRPMIC Fire Department will provide the instruction and facilities for its training program, and College will, in turn, provide those in the training (“Students”) with college credit for the successful completion of the training under the terms specified in the Agreement.

The financial arrangement is a balanced exchange. The SRPMIC will pay SCC the tuition for each student enrolled and provide the instruction for each class. In exchange, SCC will pay the SRPMIC a fee for facility and equipment rental. All faculty will meet faculty hiring qualifications prior to teaching.
