	Intergovernmental Agreement for Dual Enrollment with Snowflake Unified School District No. 5	Dr. Maria Harper-Marinick

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Maricopa County Community College District Governing Board authorize entry into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) on behalf of its colleges with Snowflake Unified School District No. 5 for their dual enrollment program.

Justification

State law requires that, before a community college district may offer credit or non-credit courses outside of its district, the district seeking to offer the courses must enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the district of the county in which the courses will be held. See Arizona Revised Statutes §15-1470. Under an IGA that MCCCCD has entered into with the Navajo County Community College District, MCCCCD is permitted to enter into this IGA for the academic year 2008-2009 to offer the courses described below.

This IGA will permit Mesa Community College to provide classes, as requested by SUSD, to SUSD's high school students in Cisco Technology.

The IGA is the standard dual enrollment agreement. It establishes curriculum and enrollment standards for MCCCCD's dual enrollment program to comply with applicable law. It also implements MCCCCD's single financial model for dual enrollment. All students either pay tuition or qualify for a school district scholarship, and the college's reimbursement to the school districts for instruction, facilities and supplies is calculated according to a set formula.
