**Justification**

The Title V grant titled Achieving Academic Success is a capacity-building program to achieve and maintain institutional self-sufficiency by focusing on increasing student academic success so students complete college level courses successfully and persist from semester to semester.

College level “gatekeeper” courses will be enhanced by developing and obtaining resources to address deficiencies in skill mastery and content knowledge. The program will significantly increase student academic success in gatekeeper courses, cross-disciplinary communication and collaboration, student interest and access to science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) careers, student retention and persistence rates and enhance the academic quality of the courses.
