	Intergovernmental Agreement Between Mesa Community College and Tempe Union High School District No. 213	Dr. Maria Harper-Marinick Dr. Wayne Giles

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Governing Board approve an Intergovernmental Agreement between Mesa Community College (Regional Academy) and Tempe Union High School District No. 213 on behalf of Desert Vista High School and Tempe Union High School for the 2007-2008 fiscal year ending June 30, 2008. This agreement is for training and support services for the SC\* curriculum to be provided to Desert Vista High School and Tempe Union High School as Cisco Local Academies for an annual participation fee of \$550.00 per school.

\*SC (Sponsored Curriculum) – curriculum provided by Cisco, Inc. but not produced by Cisco, Inc. Curriculum includes IT Essentials I & II.

**Justification**

In consideration of support services provided by the Regional Academy as stated in Paragraph 2.2.3.1 of the agreement, Local Academy agrees to pay the Regional Academy an annual participation fee of \$550.00 per school. When Local Academy renews this Agreement for another year, the payment shall be due and payable before any such renewal is in effect.

The Local Academy shall agree to pay the rate of \$90.00 per instructor, per training day, per class, orientation, or continuing education event as stated in Paragraphs 2.2.3.2, 2.2.3.3 and 2.2.3.4. All fees will be paid at the time of registration.

This Intergovernmental Agreement specifies the responsibilities of the Local Academy, Regional Academy, and Cisco systems, Inc., including course delivery, fees, and instructor training.

This agreement does *not* imply in any way a dual enrollment agreement.
