If you are having difficulty paying for your medications due to the rising costs of prescription drugs, please take a moment to review the following programs possibly available to you.

The Rx Outreach Program, managed by Express Scripts Specialty Distribution Services, Inc., offers medications to those who qualify at an affordable price. There are over 110 different medications available through this program. To find out if you qualify for this program, please log on to the web site at www.rxoutreach.com or call 1-800-769-3880. Certain income limitations do apply.

Wal-Mart and Target are now offering a 30 day supply of certain generic medications for \$4.00. K-Mart is offering a 90 day supply for \$15.00. For a listing of the available medications and details about the programs, please visit the following web sites:
