



Employee Access to MCCCDC's Wireless Networks

This brochure was written under the assumption that the employee is familiar with accessing wireless connections from their computing device.

Revisions will take place once the College Identity Management System (CIMS) is implemented late 2009.



Employees traveling to the various MCCCDC facilities for meetings can access wireless networks for Enterprise Email (MEMO) and web browsing. Each site provides instructions for access which may or may not require Helpdesk assistance. This brochure will help to guide you through that process.

Wireless Access by Campus

CGCC

Wireless access at CGCC requires a CGCC login ID. If an account does not already exist, please contact the Helpdesk at 480.732.7025 between 7:00 am and 7:30 pm M-R and 7:00 am-5:00 pm on Fridays. If a CGCC Login ID already exists, further instructions to access this network are available at: www.cgcc.edu/wireless

District Office & Emerald Point

Wireless connectivity is available throughout the District Office and Emerald Point facilities. To access the wireless network you will need to connect to the **DOGUEST** network.

If you require printing capabilities, a District Domain account is required. Contact the DO Helpdesk at 480.731.8632 between 6:00 am and 5:00 pm M-F for assistance in obtaining a Domain account.

EMCC

In most areas of the campus, EMCC has 802.11 a/b/g wireless network access. This means that if you own a device (such as a laptop or PDA) that has an 802.11a/b/g card in it, you can access the EMCC network. MCC

MCC has two "authenticated" wireless networks - one that broadcasts and is known as **mesacc**, which is primarily for students, although employees can log in to it - and another named **mccemp** that only employees can log in to. These authenticated networks accept either MCC usernames or MEMO usernames and passwords. A Wireless Network Access information page is available at:

GCC

Wireless access at GCC requires an **eGCC** Login Account. If an account does not already exist, please contact the Help Desk at 623.845.3555 (option 2 or 3) between 7:00 am and 7:30 pm M-R and 7:00 am and 5:00 pm Friday to obtain a guest wireless account. If an **eGCC** account already exists, further instructions to access this network are available at:

GWCC

Free wireless access for all MCCC employees can be accessed by choosing **GATEWAYCC** from the available wireless networks and clicking "connect", then logging in using the MEID and password. Connectivity at Maricopa Skill Center and remote sites is currently unavailable with further implementation planned for the near future.

PC

Wireless access at PC requires a **PCLAN** Account. If an Account does not already exist, please contact the Helpdesk at 602.285.7200 between 8:00 and 7:00 pm M-R and 8:00 and 4:00 pm on Fridays to obtain one. Please provide 48 hours notice for identity validation.

PVCC

Upon opening a browser window on campus, you will be directed to a wireless network login page. Use your MEID and directory password to login. A FAQ is available at: <http://www.pvc.maricopa.edu/wifi/>

RSC

Public wireless access for anyone at Rio Tempe can be accessed by choosing **Rio Public** from the available wireless networks and clicking "connect". No further authentication is required. Should you have any issues, please contact the Rio Help Desk at 480.517.8600.

SCC

Wireless guest access for MCCC employees can be obtained via the SCC Helpdesk by calling 480-423-6274, option #3 (during normal business hours). SMCC

SMCC currently provides college-wide wireless access at all campus locations. Limited access is available by launching your favorite browser and following the instructions presented on the **Terms of Use** web page. Sometime after the completion of the District CIMS project, wireless users will be required to logon using their MEID and Memo password.
