**COLLEGE RISK ASSESSMENT FACILITATION TEAMS (CRAFT)**

Ruth Unks is working with the vice presidents of administration to establish risk assessment teams at all colleges. We will provide a laminated risk map to each CRAFT to assist them in their risk assessment process.

**MARKETING/COMMUNICATIONS**

The MIRA website continues to be an active website. Since our postcard marketing campaign in Fall 2005, the MIRA website has had 14, 404 hits.

The script for the MIRA video is currently being finalized, and the video will be produced for internal use this summer.

**RISK IDENTIFICATION**

A special MIRA meeting was held on November 6, 2007. The purpose of this meeting was risk identification. The committee reviewed key Maricopa documents (Vision, Mission, and Values Statements, Governing Board Outcome Statements, Environmental Scans, Risk Environment, Culture & Appetite Description, and Risk Registers) and based on these reviews, will add new risks and opportunities to the Risk Register/Best Practices Statements. Best practices statements have been added to this Risk Register. Also, interviews will be conducted with selected members of CEC and other employee councils to receive their input regarding new risks. New risks that are identified will be formally assessed using the Resolver Ballot software system on July 15, 2008.

**TRAINING**

Ruth Unks presented “Risk Assessment Tools” at CGCC on April 9, 2008 and at SCC on April 10, 2008.

Dorothy Gjerdrum, ERM consultant, provided training for the MIRA project team on February 28, 2008.

Ruth Unks was a co-presenter for the “ERM Boot Camp” session on April 29 at the 2008 Risk & Insurance Management Society (RIMS) Conference in San Diego, CA. Ruth co-presented the 2.5 hour session with the risk managers from Chiquita International and Continental Airlines.
